

Scholarship Program

We offer educational scholarships to youth from low-income rural families whose educational goals are impeded by social and financial stresses. This merit-based scholarship enables youth with limited opportunities to receive financial aid, student support, quality education, and access to higher education.

The Scholarship Program is reserved for primary and secondary school children and a separate program manages the University Scholarship Program. A competitive selection process and a three-way contract between the student, their guardian, and Asante Africa ensures the academic success of the student.

Creating His Own Destiny

Daniel's Journey, Kenya

A timely scholarship allowed Daniel to continue his education and avoid life as a herdsman. Daniel flourished in school, becoming an elected prefect, debate club secretary, and a society leader who guided and counseled his peers. He also completed several environmental projects, making products



using waste materials and planting trees. Daniel is currently pursuing computer studies and waiting to join university, where he plans to become a physician and specialize as a pediatrician working with the physically impaired.

Grace's Journey, Tanzania

Grace and her family survived by selling homemade beer. However, Asante Africa supported Grace with a scholarship and helped her build health, financial, and social assets. Encouragement and hard work gave Grace the tools to graduate 1st in her 7th grade. Now, she is a role model for her mother and grandmother, who see the potential for a brighter future for the entire family.

A single scholarship has the potential to free up resources for other children of the family. Our beneficiaries become role models within their communities of potential and possibility. They also share their financial knowledge and business management skills with their extended family and become agents of change.
