SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK, NORTHERN TANZANIA

6 ROOMS | OPEN YEAR ROUND | AIRSTRIP: NDUTU [Dec- Apr], SERONERA [May, Jun, Nov] , KOGATENDE [Jul - Oct]

## SERENGETI SAFARI CAMP: SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK, NORTHERN TANZANIA



### LOCATION:

The camp moves seasonally 4 -5 times a year to follow the movements of the migration, but it will not move during your stay. Camp movements are pre-planned in an effort to be within reach of the wildebeest migration, but this cannot always be guaranteed given the unpredictability of nature and weather conditions.

### SETTING:

We take great care over choosing a campsite but every one will be different! Always that little bit further from the crowds, in our own corner of Serengeti wilderness.

### ACCOMMODATION:

6 large walk-in safari tents, with dressing room area separating the beds from the new eco-flush loos and safari bucket showers. There is a separate lounge and dining tent and a traditional safari fireplace for sundowners. The family tent has two en suite bedrooms and adjoining sitting area.

### SEASONS:

December to April: the camp is on the southern Serengeti Plains with access to the main herds as they calve through February. Birding is excellent during this time, as is general game viewing. May to Early July: Western Corridor. The migration patterns can be unpredictable at this time of year, but the wildebeest rut (May) and the crossing of the Grumeti River (June/July) are spectacular if caught. Mid-June to November: northern Serengeti close to either the Mara or Sand Rivers, offering great game viewing and crossings of either of the rivers. Late November: the camp heads south again, arriving on the southern Serengeti Plains around mid-December.

### ACTIVITIES:

Shared twice daily game drives (with an option to upgrade to private car & guide for complete flexibility) in custom built 4WD vehicles. Opportunities to see the great wildebeest and zebra migration, large herds of plains game and the highest concentration of predators in Africa. Nomad guides are

experienced and knowledgeable and great company on safari. Hot air balloon flights.

**CHILD POLICY:** We are delighted to welcome children over the age of 8 at Serengeti Safari Camp.

### GETTING THERE:

Fly by private charter, or scheduled flights to the nearest airstrip (vary according to the seasons - contact your Nomad consultant for details), or drive in 4WD safari vehicles from our other northern camps.

### OPEN:

Year round.

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

## ENTAMANU NGORONGORO: NGORONGORO CRATER, NORTHERN TANZANIA

### GPS COORDS:

03°06.063'S,  
035°31.0004'E  
Altitude: 2200m/7200ft

### LOCATION:

On the remote North Western edge of the Ngorongoro Crater rim, just beyond the Seneto descent road, approached along a private access road.

### SETTING:

Our camp is uniquely off the beaten track but right on the Crater rim, and has exceptional views both down into Ngorongoro Crater from one side (sunrise), and out over the Serengeti from the other (perfect for sundowners).

Prepare for a hot high-altitude sun, cold nights, and a wind which can be strong [warm clothes are a must year round!]. This is the wild side of the Crater where the exclusivity and views are unsurpassed.

### ACCOMMODATION:

Entamanu Ngorongoro has seven canvas rooms elevated on wooden platforms, with two family rooms made up of two full size rooms and a shared bathroom. Each room has indoor heating and en-suite bathrooms with hot and cold running water, and flush loos. Every effort has been made to create comfort in this elemental place.

### HIGHLIGHTS:

Entamanu Ngorongoro (meaning 'circle' in Maa) is the only place in the world where you can enjoy views into both the Crater and the Serengeti. Offering an unspoilt, unparalleled experience of the Crater, and the land and culture that surrounds it. It is a place to escape to, from which to learn and understand where the Crater fits as part of the wider environment.

### ACTIVITIES:

Game drives into the Crater, explorations of the surrounding highlands, guided walks, bush picnics and sundowners. Maasai interactions with neighbouring communities.

### CHILD POLICY:

Children of 8 and above at Entamanu Ngorongoro, although only children over 12 are permitted to go out on guided walks.

### GETTING THERE:

Regular schedule flights from Arusha/Dar/Zanzibar and other areas of Tanzania, to Manyara Airstrip which is around 2hrs road transfer to camp. Entamanu Ngorongoro is also easy driving distance from Arusha, Tarangire, Karatu and southern Serengeti so perfectly placed for inclusions in a driven northern Tanzania itinerary.

### OPEN:

Entamanu Ngorongoro is open all year round.
